BRENTWOOD CHURCH OFFERS WALK THROUGH JERUSALEM EXPERIENCE *Community invited to re-live Jesus' last week in one afternoon*

BRENTWOOD, Tenn., (March 22, 2009) – So what was it really like during Jesus' last week? One Brentwood church is giving residents a chance to find out.

A special Walk Through Jerusalem Experience will be offered free to the public on Saturday, April 11, 2009 from 10:00 a.m. to 1:00 p.m. at New Hope Community Church, 605 Wilson Pike, Brentwood. The event, to be held in the church's Fellowship Hall, is intended to give both children and adults a glimpse into the sights and sounds of Jerusalem, from Jesus' triumphant entry on a donkey, to his crucifixion and empty tomb, during that critical time.

"Live action experiences are a great way for everyone to better understand the reality of Easter," said Sandy Waight, director of the church's Children's Ministry. "The story of tragedy, pain and suffering – as well as the ultimate plan of God's redemption for mankind through the sacrifice of His Son – becomes even more real when you can interact with the various scenes from Jesus' last week. We believe visitors will get a real sense of the week through this experience."
